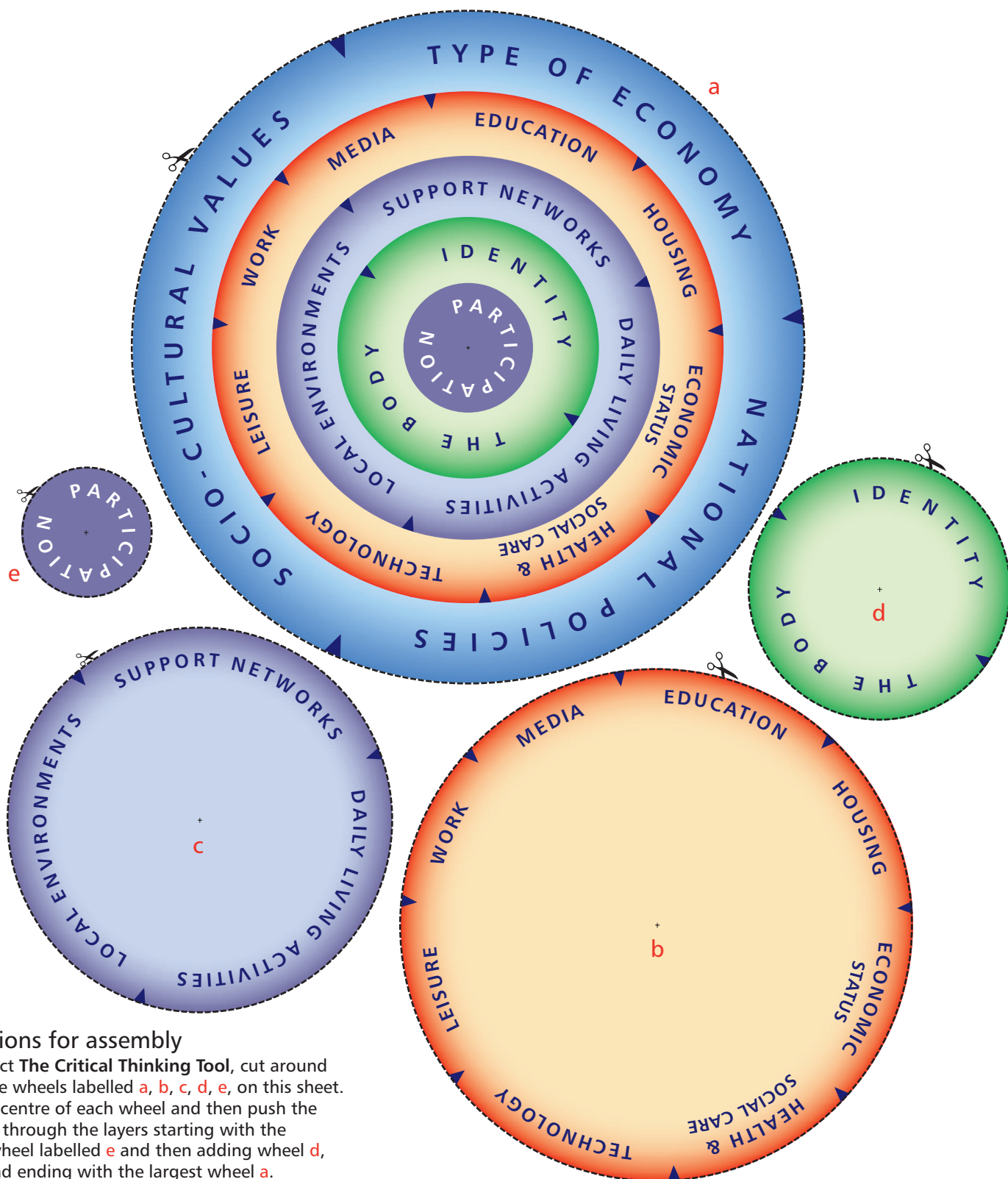


The Critical Thinking Tool

To construct **The Critical Thinking Tool**, cut around each of the wheels labelled **a, b, c, d, e**, on this sheet. Pierce the centre of each wheel and then push the connector through the layers starting with the smallest wheel labelled **e** and then adding wheel **d, c** and **b** and ending with the largest wheel **a**.
