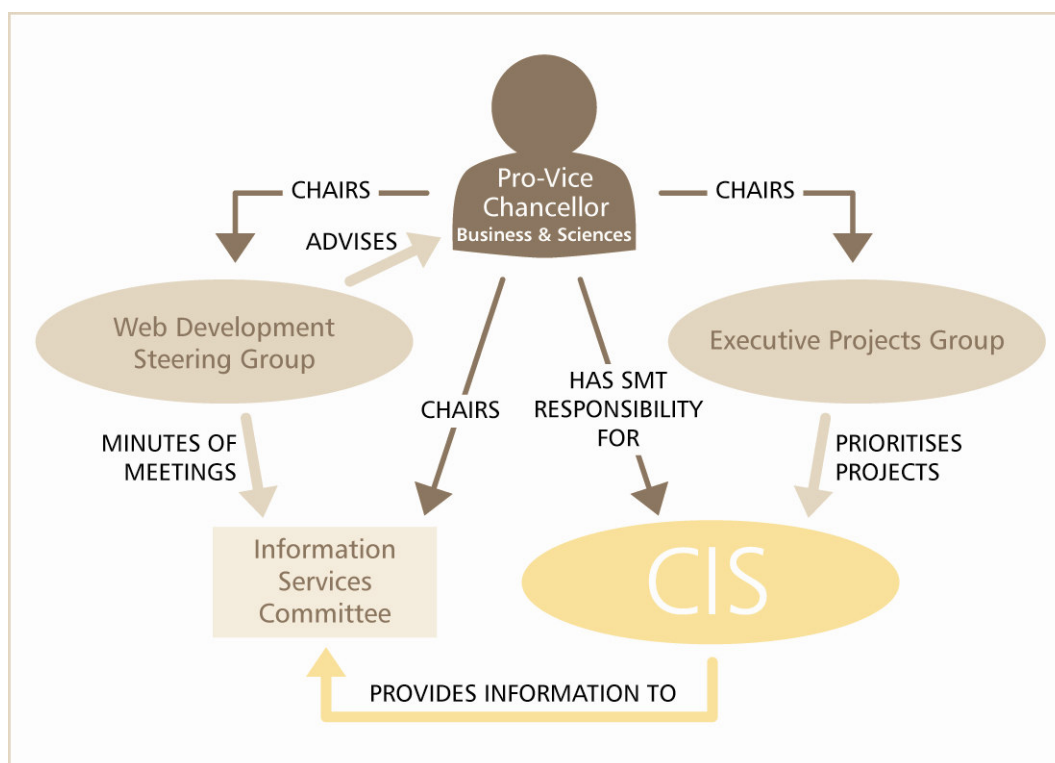


Relationships and Interactions between the Executive Projects Group, Web Development Steering Group and Information Services Committee



The Executive Projects group consists of four members of the Senior Management Team (SMT) together with the Head of Computing Services and the Head of Corporate Information Services. The group determines the strategic priorities amongst competing projects if CIS has insufficient resources to complete all projects in the timescale required.

Other projects are authorised directly by the Pro-Vice Chancellor (Business and Sciences) in line with business needs.

The Web Development Steering Group is tasked with providing advice to the Pro-Vice Chancellor (Business and Sciences) on the development of the website. The group is not part of the formal committee structure nor does it have an executive role. The minutes of the Web Development Steering Group are forwarded to the Information Services Committee for information.

The Information Services Committee (ISC) is a committee of Academic Board and is thus part of the formal committee structure. Its primary role is to oversee the development and implementation of the information strategy. ISC performs a deliberative function and receives progress reports from the Heads of Learning and Information Services, including the Head of Corporate Information Services.
