Student and Staff Sustainable Travel initiatives - 6th September 2010

Stagecoach Discounted Fares for Canterbury, Broadstairs and Folkestone. The University is committed to further developing sustainable transport alternatives to assist students and staff to reduce car travel across the campus network. The Car Parking Policy currently being implemented acknowledges the need to do more to develop alternative transport options for each campus recognising the differing transport challenges of each location for students and staff.

The University has recently agreed a contract for the next academic year to discount student and staff travel with the Stagecoach Bus Company. Season tickets are based on the following term dates:

Michaelmas Term

Monday 6th September to Friday 17th December (15 weeks)

Lent Term

Tuesday 4th January to Friday 8th April (14 weeks)

Trinity Term

Monday 18th April to Friday 22nd July (14 weeks)

The following discounts will apply from 6th September 2010 until 9th September 2011:

Stagecoach will make available the annual City Megariders in Canterbury, Thanet and Folkestone for a University discounted rate of;

Staff: £340 per annum

Students: £240 per annum or with a termly option of £120 per term.

The annual Megarider Gold covering unlimited travel on Stagecoach East Kent buses will be sold at a discounted rate of:

Staff: £660 per annum

Students: £600 per annum

Staff may be required to pay tax on the subsidy, depending on their personal circumstances.
