

SPECIAL REGULATIONS: POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION COLLABORATIVE LEADERSHIP

INTRODUCTION

- 1 The Special Regulations apply to the following course:
 - Postgraduate Diploma Business Administration Collaborative Leadership
- 2 These Special Regulations apply only to previous students of or graduates of the Senior Leader Apprenticeship (SLA) that wish to enter the above course following completion of the SLA.

ASSESSMENT AND REASSESSMENT

- 3 While undertaking the SLA, marks for participants' formative assessments will be assessed summatively against the criteria for the Postgraduate Diploma Business Administration Collaborative Leadership. These marks are for internal use and will not be shared with students or employer during the period of study on the SLA.
- 4 Upon completion of the End Point Assessment for the SLA or on completion of all learning for the course, SLA participants can request that the University assesses their formative work for an award of Postgraduate Diploma Business Administration Collaborative Leadership.
- 5 The regulations for assessment and reassessment set out in the Regulations for Taught Awards apply, excepting the following:
 - a. Formative work completed for the SLA, when summatively assessed against the criteria for the PG Dip Business Administration Collaborative Leadership, is counted as a first assessment attempt.
 - b. The University regulations for compensation at this level of study apply. A student will not be eligible for compensation if, in future, they undertake the MBA award.
 - c. The University regulations for reassessment, including the number of reassessment attempts permitted at this Level, apply.
- 6 The course is excluded from University regulations regarding Reassessment with Attendance.

METHOD AND TIMING OF REASSESSMENT

- 7 A student's first reassessment attempt must be taken in the next available timetabled assessment period.

- 8 A student's second reassessment attempt must be taken in the next available timetabled assessment period without attendance.

CLASSIFICATION

- 9 The regulations for award classification align with the General Regulations for the Conferment of Awards.
