

SPECIAL REGULATIONS: MSc CLINICAL REPORTING

INTRODUCTION

1 These special regulations relate only to the following programme:

- MSc Clinical Reporting

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

2.1 The requirements for admissions are those set out in the General Regulations for the Conferment of Awards with the exception that entrants are normally required to have:

- (a) A professional registration to practice in radiography or a related discipline; and a relevant first degree or professional award.

2.2 In addition:

- (a) Practitioners will be working in a relevant field of radiographic practice and will have sufficient access to the relevant range of clinical practice to support their studies.
- (b) Students must be supported by their employer and two referees, one of whom is a Consultant Radiologist prepared to act as a liaison mentor.
- (c) The student's employer must be prepared to commit support through a formalised Student Learning Contract and Clinical Learning Agreement.

ASSESSMENT

3 All elements of assessment in all modules must be passed.

COMPENSATION

4 The programme is excluded from University regulations regarding compensation.
