EXIT AWARDS

1. For students who do not complete or pass the “Data Intelligence Placement” module, the Board of Examiners must consider recommending the following exit awards accordingly:
 - a. To qualify for a Master of Science in Data Intelligence students must be awarded 180 credits;
 - b. To qualify for a Postgraduate Diploma in Data Intelligence students must be awarded at least 120 credits;
 - c. To qualify for a Postgraduate Certificate Data Intelligence students must be awarded at least 60 credits.
2. For students who complete and pass the “Data Intelligence Placement” module, but do not pass the total number of credits required for the target award, the Board of Examiners must consider recommending the following exit awards accordingly:
 - a. To qualify for a Master of Science in Data Intelligence with Placement students must be awarded 180 credits and pass the “Data Intelligence Placement” module;
 - b. To qualify for a Postgraduate Diploma in Data Intelligence with Placement students must be awarded at least 120 credits and pass the “Data Intelligence Placement” module;
 - c. To qualify for a Postgraduate Certificate Data Intelligence with Placement students must be awarded at least 60 credits and pass the “Data Intelligence Placement” module.

3. The following core non-credit bearing module will be pass/fail only:
 - Data Intelligence Placement – P19022

REASSESSMENT

4. A student is not permitted to undertake a further placement in order to undertake the reassessment. The reassessment will be undertaken through a written assessment.
