AWARD

1. The only awards for these courses that infer eligibility to apply for professional registration with a licensed professional engineering institution are:

- BEng (Hons) Architectural Engineering.
 - BEng (Hons) Biomedical Engineering
 - BEng (Hons) Building Services Engineering
 - BEng (Hons) Chemical Engineering
 - BEng (Hons) General Engineering
 - BEng (Hons) Mechanical Engineering
 - BEng (Hons) Product Design Engineering.
2. Where students do not meet the criteria for the awards listed above, they may be offered an appropriate exit award that does not confer eligibility for professional registration with a licensed professional engineering institution.
 3. Where, at the end of Level 6, students have had over 30 credits compensation applied, they will exit with a BSc (Hons) instead of BEng (Hons), which does not confer accreditation by licensed professional engineering institutions.
 4. The award titles stated in the above table under 'exit awards' are available to students not recommended for the target professional awards.

COMPENSATION (APPLICABLE TO ALL AWARDS LISTED IN COURSE TITLE BOX)

5. The University compensation regulations apply except in the following situations:
 - i. the normal University rules for compensation are permitted at Foundation Year Level only;
 - ii. during Levels 4-6, compensation can only be applied on one occasion for up to 30-credits; the mark attained by the student in the module to be compensated must be at least 30%;
 - iii. the automatic awarding of compensation does not apply to Levels 4-6. For each Level 4-6 module, students will be offered the opportunity to undertake reassessment attempts for which they are eligible.
 - iv. Compensation will only be applied after all reassessment attempts where the conditions in (b) and (c) are met.

DOUBLE MARKING

7. All assessments at Level 6 will be double marked in accordance with the University's standard double marking policy.
