1. The Regulations for Taught Awards apply in full to this course, except as detailed in these Additional Course Regulations. In any conflict between the two, this document shall take precedence.

TRAILING CREDIT

2. A Foundation Year student will be allowed to progress with trailing credit into level 4 of their course where (a) a deferred first attempt is being trailed, (b) the student has outstanding reassessment attempts and (c) no more than 20 credits are being trailed.
3. A student permitted to trail credit to Level 4, who does not pass the trailed credit by the end of Level 4, must pass 120 credits at Level 4, either directly or through compensation, to be permitted to progress to Level 5.

COMPENSATION

4. A Board of Examiners will apply compensation and permit a Foundation Year student to progress to Level 4 if they have:
 - (i) passed modules equivalent to the value of 100 credits; AND
 - (ii) obtained a mark of at least 30% in the module(s) to be compensated; AND
 - (iii) obtained a combined average mark of at least 40% for all graded modules across level 0.
