

SPECIAL REGULATIONS: BSc (HONS) HEALTHCARE PRACTICE

INTRODUCTION

- 1 These Special Regulations enable the following awards to be made.
 - (a) Bachelor of Science with Honours on the successful completion of 120 credits at Level 6
 - (b) Graduate Diploma on the successful completion of 120 credits at Level 6 for those entrants who hold a first degree from a recognised higher education institution
 - (c) Bachelor of Science on the successful completion of 60 credits at Level 6
 - (d) Graduate Certificate on the successful completion of 60 credits at Level 6 for those entrants who hold a first degree from a recognised higher education institution
 - (e) University Diploma in Neonatal Intensive Care on successful completion of 60 credits at Level 6 comprising the modules; Pathophysiology of Neonatal Care, Practice Module for Neonatal Care and Management of the Complex Neonate.
- 2 The titles of awards covered by these Special Regulations are specified in Schedule One.

INDIVIDUAL MODULES

- 3 A student may register for no more than two individual modules without registering for an award bearing programme. The student must meet any prerequisites for the particular module.
- 4 Where a student successfully completes an individual module, the credits will be awarded and a University transcript issued as evidence.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE AND DELIVERY

- 5 Registration on the programme is a maximum of four years from the date of the initial registration

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

- 6 The programme is subject to University regulations with regard to RPL, a maximum of 60 credits can be awarded via RPL in the programme where the prior learning can be matched. to one of the modules in the portfolio. Students who have used the RPL process may not be awarded an Ordinary Degree on completion of 60 credits. Acceptance will be dependent upon all core elements of the programme having been completed unless RPL credits have been able to be matched to core modules within the programme.
- 7 Where students are transferring credit which has been accrued within the previous five years from the University of Brighton, University of Greenwich, Portsmouth University or the University of Surrey the mark awarded will appear on their transcript.

ASSESSMENT

- 8 Students must pass all modules.
