AWARD

1. Where students do not meet the criteria for the LLB (Hons) Law, they may be offered an appropriate exit award that does not infer eligibility for QLD.
2. The following exit awards are available to students not recommended for the LLB (Hons) Law
 - i. BA (Hons) Law.

COMPENSATION

3. The University compensation regulations apply except as stated in clauses i-iv below as per QLD requirements.
 - i. For the LLB (Hons) Law compensation can be applied only once throughout the course to one of the eight Foundation of Legal Knowledge (FLK) modules at any level:

- ii. Foundation of Legal Knowledge modules:
 - a. Criminal Law
 - b. Contract Law
 - c. Public Law 1 (Constitutional Law)
 - d. Land Law
 - e. Public Law 2 (Administrative Law)
 - f. Law of Torts
 - g. Law of the European Union
 - h. Equity and the Law of Trusts
- iii. The mark attained by a student in the FLK module to be compensated is not less than 35%
- iv. The automatic awarding of compensation is waived. For each FLK module, students will be offered the opportunity to undertake all reassessments for which they are eligible before any compensation is applied for the failed FLK module.
