PROTECTED AWARDS FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING THE COURSE FROM SEPTEMBER 2025

3. The only awards for this course that count as a Qualifying Law Degree (QLD) are
 - (i) LLB (Hons) Law
 - (ii) LLB (Hons) Law with Criminology.
4. Where students do not meet the criteria for the above awards, they may be offered an appropriate alternative award that is not a Qualifying Law Degree.

5. The following alternative awards are available to students not recommended a Qualifying Law Degree:
- (i) BA (Hons) Law
 - (ii) BA (Hons) Law with Criminology.

PROTECTED AWARDS FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING THE COURSE BEFORE SEPTEMBER 2025

6. The only awards for this course that count as a Qualifying Law Degree (QLD) are:
- (i) LLB (Hons) Law
 - (ii) LLB (Hons) with Business
 - (iii) LLB (Hons) with Finance
 - (iv) LLB (Hons) with Criminology
 - (v) LLB (Hons) with Forensic Investigation
 - (vi) LLB (Hons) with History
 - (vii) LLB (Hons) with International Relations
 - (viii) LLB (Hons) with Politics
 - (ix) LLB (Hons) with Sociology.
7. Where students do not meet the criteria for the above awards, they may be offered an appropriate alternative award that is not a Qualifying Law Degree.

COMPENSATION FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING THE COURSE FROM SEPTEMBER 2025

9. For the LLB (Hons) awards, compensation can be applied only once throughout the course to one of the eight Foundation of Legal Knowledge (FLK) modules at any level.
10. Foundations of Legal Knowledge modules for cohorts from September 2025
- (i) Criminal Law

- (ii) Contract Law
 - (iii) Social Justice in the English Legal System
 - (iv) Land Law
 - (v) Public Law
 - (vi) Torts Law
 - (vii) European Union Law - Dissertation Project
 - (viii) Equity and Trusts.
11. The mark attained by a student in the Foundations of Legal Knowledge module to be compensated must be not less than 35%.
12. The automatic awarding of compensation does not apply. For each Foundation of Legal Knowledge module, students will be offered the opportunity to undertake all reassessment for which they are eligible before any compensation is applied for the failed Foundations of Legal Knowledge module.

COMPENSATION FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING THE COURSE BEFORE SEPTEMBER 2025

13. For the LLB (Hons) awards compensation can be applied only once throughout the course to one of the eight Foundations of Legal Knowledge modules at any level.
14. Foundations of Legal Knowledge modules for cohorts pre-September 2025:
- (i) Criminal Law
 - (ii) Contract Law
 - (iii) Public Law 1 (Constitutional Law)
 - (iv) Land Law
 - (v) Public Law 2 (Administrative Law)
 - (vi) Law of Torts
 - (vii) Law of the European Union
 - (viii) Equity and the Law of Trusts.
15. The mark attained by a student in the Foundations of Legal Knowledge module to be compensated must be not less than 35%.
16. The automatic awarding of compensation does not apply. For each Foundation of Legal Knowledge module, students will be offered the opportunity to undertake all reassessment for which they are eligible before any compensation is applied for the failed Foundations of Legal Knowledge module.
