 - (iii) Human Anatomy, Physiology and Biomechanics at Level 5;
 - (iv) Applied Science Major Project at Level 6;
 - (v) Sustainable Futures: Geographies of Tomorrow at Level 6.
4. The Competency Portfolio assessment has the outcome Pass/Fail and does not contribute to the module mark.
5. The Competency Portfolio must be passed in order to pass the module.
6. A pass constitutes all designated competencies passed.

HURDLES FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING THE COURSES BEFORE SEPTEMBER 2026

7. All modules contain a 'Portfolio' component of assessment, with the exception of the Dissertation/Individual Study and Level 7 modules.
8. The Competency Portfolio assessment has the outcome Pass/Fail and does not contribute to the module mark.
9. The Competency Portfolio must be passed in order to pass the module.
10. A pass constitutes 50% or more skills passed and must include any listed as "required".

TRAILING CREDIT FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING THE COURSES BEFORE SEPTEMBER 2026

11. Trailing credit is not permitted.

12. Compensation is not permitted for following module: Applied Sciences: Major Project (Level 6).

 - (v) Honours Project in Food Science & Nutrition;
 - (vi) Honours Project in Geography;
 - (vii) Honours Project in Human Biology;
 - (viii) Honours Project in Plant Science;
 - (ix) Honours Project in Wildlife Ecology & Conservation Science.
14. Compensation is not permitted for following Level 7 modules:
- (i) Research Project in Biomedical Science.
