INTRODUCTION

1. The Regulations for Taught Awards apply in full to this course, except as detailed in these Additional Course Regulations. In any conflict between the two, this document shall take precedence.
2. Where the course is undertaken with a Foundation Year, these additional course regulations apply to levels 4, 5 and 6 only.

PROTECTED AWARD

3. The only awards for these courses that confer eligibility to apply for registration with the Nursing & Midwifery Council (NMC) are:
 - (i) BSc (Hons) Nursing (Adult)
 - (ii) BSc (Hons) Nursing (Child)
 - (iii) BSc (Hons) Nursing (Mental Health).

4. To be awarded BSc (Hons) Nursing (Adult / Child / Mental Health), students must successfully meet the requirements concerning attendance and professional practice, together with the requirements of the regulatory bodies relating to student conduct, good health, and good character.
5. The award title BSc (Hons) Nursing (Adult / Child / Mental Health) cannot be offered as an aegrotat award.
6. Where students do not meet the criteria for the BSc (Hons) Nursing (Adult / Child / Mental Health), they may be offered an appropriate alternative award as set out in the course documentation. These awards do not confer eligibility for registration with the NMC.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

7. For applicants who do not have a current registration at first or second level with the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC), RPL of up to a maximum of 50% of the course will be considered, provided all the requirements are met in full.
8. For applicants who have a current UK registration for a separate field at first or second level with the NMC, RPL of up to the University maximum will be considered, providing all requirements are met in full.

CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION

9. Students are required to make a formal declaration of good health and good character at the beginning of each academic year.
10. Students must remain in good standing in relation to fitness to practice.

PERIODS OF REGISTRATION

9. The normal minimum and maximum period of registration for students recommended for a BSc (Hons) Nursing (Adult / Child / Mental Health) is 3 years minimum and 6 years' maximum for full-time students. This covers the entire period of study, whether undertaken at CCCU or another institution, including periods of interruption, reassessment and credit transferred from another HEI or course.
10. Minimum and maximum periods of registration will be adjusted accordingly for students with RPL at the point of RPL approval in line with NMC Requirements [applies only to students commencing the course from September 2025].

HURDLES

11. All components of assessment must be passed.

COMPENSATION

12. Compensation is not permitted.

PROGRESSION: TRAILING CREDIT FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING THE COURSE FROM SEPTEMBER 2025

13. Trailing credit is not permitted, except as detailed below:

14. Where students at level 4 have successfully completed the practice assessment, but have not completed the required practice hours, they may trail up to 150 hours of practice into level 5 of the course. Students who are unable to complete the outstanding practice hours within the first semester of Level 5 will be required either to interrupt their studies until the next academic year, when the hours can be completed, or to withdraw from the course with any credit or default exit awards achieved.
15. Where students at level 5 have successfully completed the practice assessment, but have not completed the required practice hours, they may trail up to 150 hours of practice into level 6 of the course. Students who are unable to complete the outstanding practice hours within the first semester of Level 6 will be required either to interrupt their studies until the next academic year, when the hours can be completed, or to withdraw from the course with any credit or default exit awards achieved.

PROGRESSION: TRAILING CREDIT FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING THE COURSE BEFORE SEPTEMBER 2025

16. Trailing credit is not permitted.
17. A student may only progress from one year or one part of the course to the next on successful completion of the required practice assessment.

FITNESS TO PRACTISE

19. The University Fitness to Practise procedure applies on this course. Where a student is subject to a Fitness to Practise referral, continuation on the course, and engagement with current and future assessment or retrieval opportunities related to professional practice will only be possible:
- (i) where the Fitness to Practise process deems this to be appropriate and
 - (ii) where any precautionary measures linked to practice are lifted.

EXTERNAL EXAMINERS

20. At least one External Examiner appointed to the course must be appropriately experienced and qualified in the relevant area of practice and, unless other arrangements are agreed with the appropriate regulatory body, be from the relevant part of the Register.
