APPLICATION AND THE RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

- 1 There are no taught Level 4 modules on the course.
- 2 Applicants may only enrol on the course after successfully completing the Accreditation Portfolio of Evidence to achieve Level 4 credit using the RPEL mechanism.
 - (a) The Accreditation Portfolio of Evidence is marked pass/fail.
 - (b) Students cannot exit the programme with a Cert HE.
- 3 Students commence the taught modules on the course at Level 5.
 - (a) A student may only apply for RPEL at Level 5 against modules marked pass/fail and for a maximum of 60 credits.

- 4 The course is excluded from University regulations regarding compensation.

AWARD CLASSIFICATION

- 5 The degree classification will be based on the weighted average of:
 - (a) the following Level 5 modules (which are not marked pass/fail only):
 - Work-Based Learning: Leadership in Practice - U18944
 - Work-Based Learning: Project Management - U18945
 - Work-Based Learning: Self-Innovation - U18946
 - (b) And the best 100 credits from Level 6

6 The weighted ratio will be 40:60 (40 Level 5; 60 Level 6).
