PROTECTED AWARDS FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING LEVEL 0 FROM SEPTEMBER 2025 AND LEVEL 4 FROM SEPTEMBER 2026

3. The only awards for this course that confer eligibility for the British Psychological Society (BPS) Graduate Basis for Chartered Membership (GBC) are as follows:

- (i) BSc (Hons) Psychology
 - (ii) BSc (Hons) Psychology (Clinical & Forensic Studies)
 - (iii) BSc (Hons) Psychology (Sports & Exercise Studies)
 - (iv) BSc (Hons) Psychology with Education Studies.
4. Students must achieve at least an upper second-class degree for GBC.
 5. Aegrotat awards do not confer eligibility for GBC.
 6. Students who are unable to meet all the academic and professional requirements may be eligible for an Alternative Award as set out in the approved course documentation. Alternative awards do not confer eligibility for the GBC.

PROTECTED AWARD FOR STUDENTS COMMENCING LEVEL 0, 4, 5 or 6 BEFORE SEPTEMBER 2025

7. The only awards for this course that confer eligibility for the BPS Graduate Basis for Chartered Membership (GBC) are as follows:
 - (i) BSc (Hons) Psychology
 - (ii) BSc (Hons) Psychology (Clinical & Forensic)
 - (iii) BSc (Hons) Psychology (Sports & Exercise)
 - (iv) BSc (Hons) Psychology with Placement Year
 - (v) BSc (Hons) Psychology (Clinical & Forensic) with Placement Year
 - (vi) BSc (Hons) Psychology (Sports & Exercise) with Placement Year
8. Students must achieve at least an upper second-class degree for the GBC.
9. Aegrotat awards do not confer eligibility for GBC.
10. Students who are unable to meet all the academic and professional requirements may be eligible for an Alternative Award as set out in the approved course documentation. Alternative awards do not confer eligibility for the GBC.
