

SPECIAL REGULATIONS: MCh IN SURGERY (AND ALL NAMED PATHWAYS)

INTRODUCTION

1. The Special Regulations relate only to the following programme:

- MCh in Surgery (Orthopaedics and Regenerative Medicine)
- MCh in Surgery (Otorhinolaryngology)
- MCh Surgery (Urology)
- MCh Surgery (Ophthalmology)
- MCh Surgery (Obstetrics and Gynaecology)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

2. The requirements for admissions are those set out in the General Regulations for the Conferment of Awards with the exception of the following.

3. All students will need to have a primary medical qualification and have a minimum of two years post qualification clinical experience. Full registration with the GMC is required if the students wish to undertake clinical practice such as assisting in operating theatre.

4. If the student is an overseas medical graduate the Admissions Office at the University will check the application in terms of:

- a. Equivalence of qualifications (by using NARIC) and
- b. English Language IELTS 6.5 (with a minimum requirement of 6.0 in writing) or equivalent.

5. Overseas students applying for the University's International Sponsorship Scheme will be required to have English Language overall score of 7.5 with a minimum requirement of 7.0 in all four areas.

6. All students will be required to complete a DBS check and Occupational Health screening prior to any clinical attachments.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

7. Candidates who satisfy the Entry Requirements will be required to undertake a telephone interview, which will be conducted by the Pathway Director. Overseas candidates applying for the University's International Sponsorship Scheme will be subject to a video conferencing style interview that meets the criteria stipulated within the University's scheme protocol.
