Terms of Reference

To advise the Governing Body with regard to:

- 1) Oversight of Governance policy and practice and recommend changes to the policy and practice in line with regulatory and best practice requirements;
- 2) Monitoring and considering annual Register of Interests and meeting declarations;
- 3) Considering nominations to the Governing Body and recommending appointment of Governors and Co-opted Members to the Governing Body;
- Considering and approving nominations of Honorary Fellowships and Doctorates;
- 5) Considering and approving nominations for naming University buildings and rooms;
- 6) Monitoring compliance with the CUC HE Code(s) of Governance;
- 7) Oversight of the Committee Terms of Reference/Standing Orders and Schedule of Delegation and co-ordination through the Committee Chairs;
- 8) Oversight of the arrangements for annual Governor informal discussions and three yearly review of governance;
- Reviewing its own effectiveness and performance annually on a 'light touch' basis and formally every three years;
- 10) Strategic oversight of Estate Master Planning;
- 11) Annual Review of Chairs Committee Terms of Reference and Work Plan; and
- 12) Those other matters deemed appropriate by the members of the Committee or identified by the Governing Body.
