## Biographical history

The Nic Costa Archive (NCA) was established in the September of 2021 with the arrival of eighteen boxes of coin-operated and amusement arcade trade artefacts, documents, and memorabilia at Canterbury Christ Church University. It was added to by Professor Alan Meades' smaller collection of research materials and will act as a resource to support researchers and academics studying this area. It is named after Nic Costa, coin-operated machine historian, artist, and author of *Automatic Pleasures*, *More Automatic Pleasures*, and *Penny in the Slot: Conceiving the Internet*, whose extensive collection makes up most of the archive.

The Archive was donated to Canterbury Christ Church University by Nic Costa and Professor Alan Meades. Further accruals are not expected.
