## **SCR Senior Common Room**

The main function of the Senior Common Room (also known as the SCR) was to provide social activities for its members and provide a framework for the discussion of issues affecting the College.

It was run by a committee of officers and had full and associate members. Full members were all members of academic staff and members of College departments while associate members were friends and benefactors of the College.

The papers mainly comprise files of general papers regarding the organisation of events, general running of the SCR and minutes of AGMs. One file contains minutes for the SCR Committee meetings.

Most of the papers were originally stored in ring binders.
