

Terms and Conditions for all competitions held by Library and Learning Resources of Canterbury Christ Church University

1. By entering the competition, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
2. For entry information, refer to relevant marketing in relation to the competition. All entries must be received by the closing date of the competition, clearly stated on all relevant marketing.
