

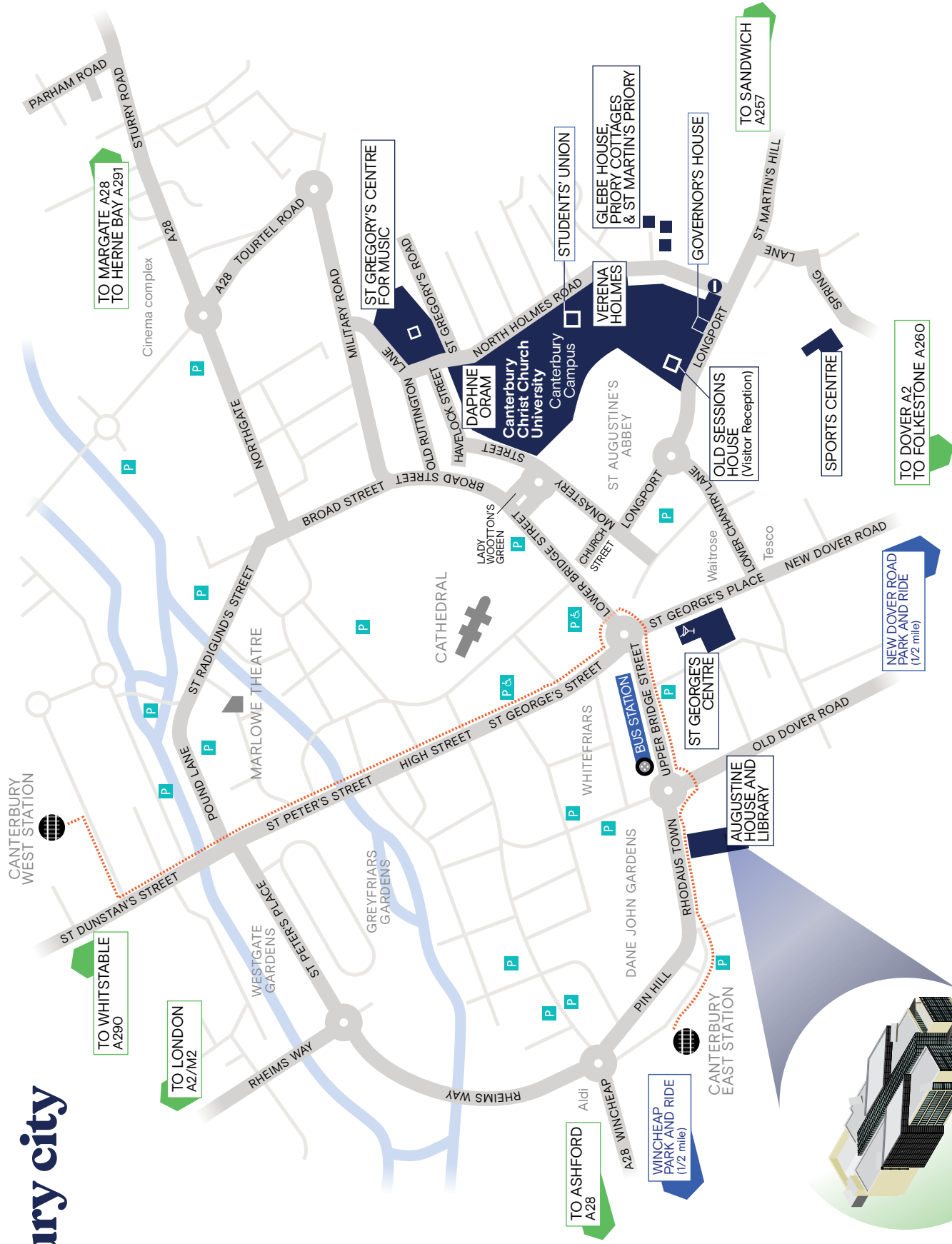

12.00 ceremony

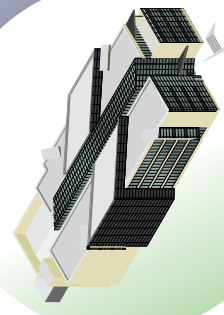
Time	Location	Action
10.00 – 11.15	Augustine House, second floor, open terrace space	Student only (no guests permitted) to collect their pre-ordered gown. We advise guests to make their way to ticket collection on the ground floor and photography on the third floor.
10.00 – 11.15	Augustine House, ground floor foyer	Collect pre-paid guest tickets at the ticket collection desk.
10.00 – 11.15	Augustine House, third floor, AH3.31	Opportunity for professional individual and family photographs – you will have a further opportunity following the ceremony.
11.15	Augustine House, ground floor	Make your way to the Hall, entrance doors open at 11.15.

12.45 – 13.30	Augustine House, second floor, open terrace space	Graduate returns their gown. Please note: graduates who fail to return their gown in time will become personally responsible for sending it back to Ede & Ravenscroft.

The student will be photographed when admitted to their qualification during the ceremony.
