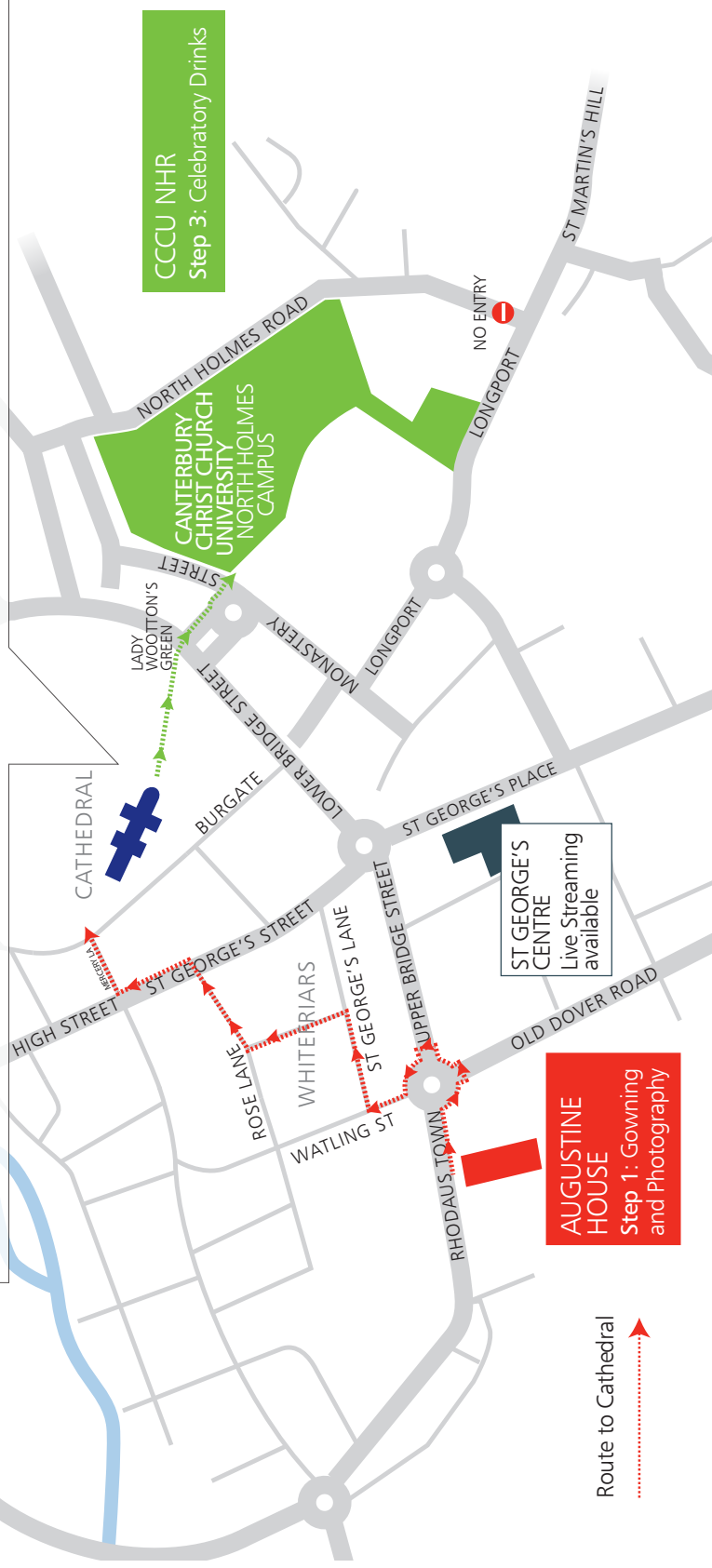
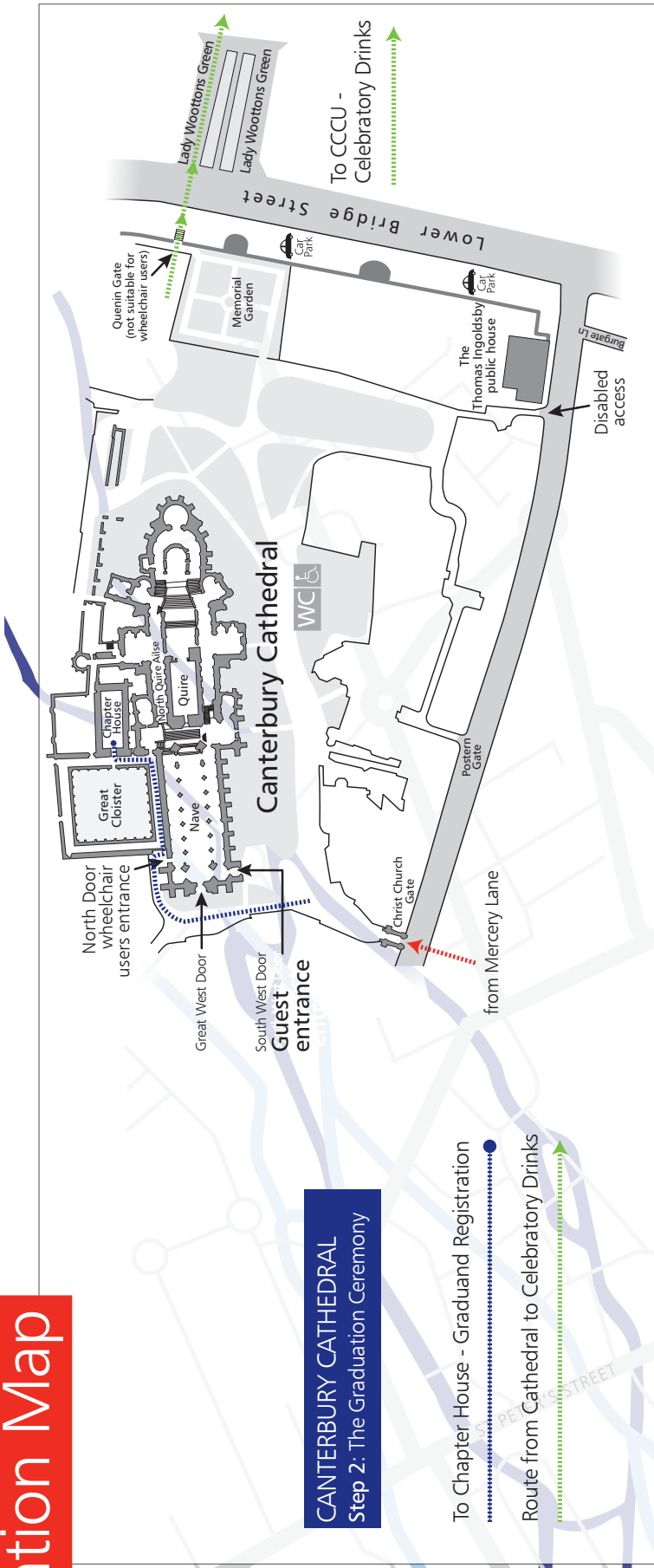

12.45 - 14.15	Augustine House, third floor, AH3.31	Graduand to first collect pre-ordered gown from Augustine House. To avoid delays, please collect your gown early if you plan on having photographs taken in Augustine Hall prior to the ceremony. It is mandatory to wear a gown at your graduation. Ede & Ravenscroft are the preferred suppliers of our gowns. 12.45 - 14.15	Augustine House, ground floor foyer	Collect pre-paid guest tickets at the ticket collection desk.
14.15 - 14.45	Chapter House, Cathedral	You must register to ensure that your name is read out during the ceremony. Once registered and seated in the Cathedral Nave you must remain in the Cathedral.
14.45	Chapter House, Cathedral	Registration closes and you will not be able to attend the ceremony. If you are running late or are no longer able to make the ceremony for any reason please call i-zone on 01227 922222.
15.00	Nave	Ceremony Marshall reads instructions to graduands and guests.
15.15 - 16.30	Nave Live streaming of the ceremony to St Georges Centre and www.canterbury.ac.uk/graduation-live	Academic, Civic Dignitaries, Honorary and Platform Party processions. The ceremony: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the ceremony will be declared open and welcoming address given • graduands will be presented for their awards – a member of staff will direct you from your seat (in presentation order) into the side aisle • you will then proceed along this aisle to the side of the platform where another member of staff will be waiting to check your name • when your name is called out you will cross the end of the Nave to shake hands (do not rush and take your time walking across the stage – be confident and don't forget to smile because Ede & Ravenscroft will be taking your photograph) • return to your seat via the centre aisle (heading towards the Great West Door) • the conferment of an Honorary Graduand of the University (if applicable) • after the presentations there will be a prayer • the ceremony will then be declared closed. The ceremony is approximately 1 hour 15.
16.30 - 17.00	Canterbury Cathedral to North Holmes Road (Anselm Building)	Recessional Procession. Graduates will process from the Cathedral to rejoin their guests and make their way to North Holmes Road for Celebratory Drinks. If you are not attending the Celebratory Drinks, please return your gown to Augustine House.
17.15 - 18.30	North Holmes Road (Food Court, Chapel and Staff Common Room.)	Celebratory Drinks. Your guest ticket must be presented upon entry.
17.15 - 18.30	North Holmes Road (Laud) Lg 25 - Gown Return/Award Photos Lg46 & Lg47 - Photography	Return your graduation gown. You will be photographed when presented with your award at the Cathedral ceremony, this can then be viewed and purchased here on the day or via the Ede & Ravenscroft website www.edeandravenscroft.com after the ceremony. Further opportunity to have professional photographs taken.
