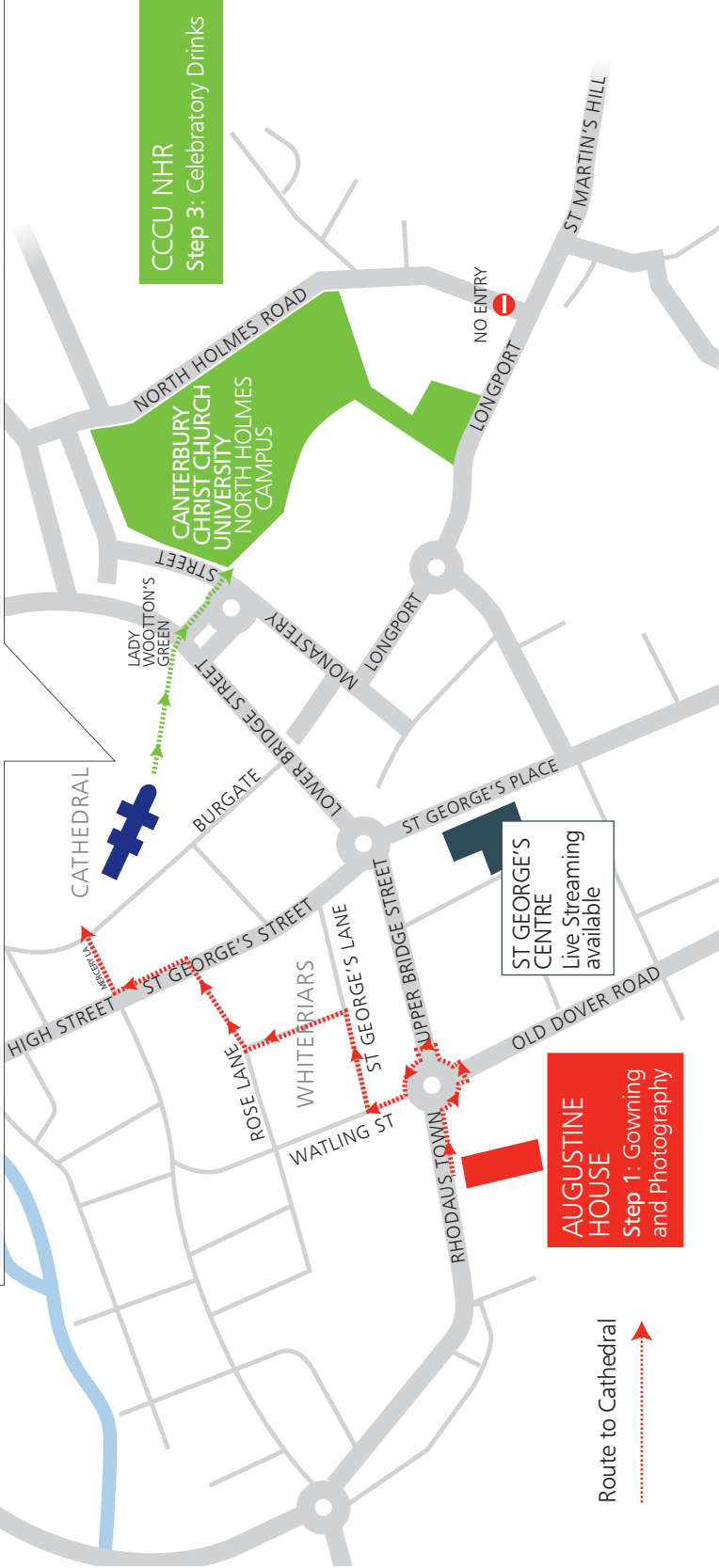
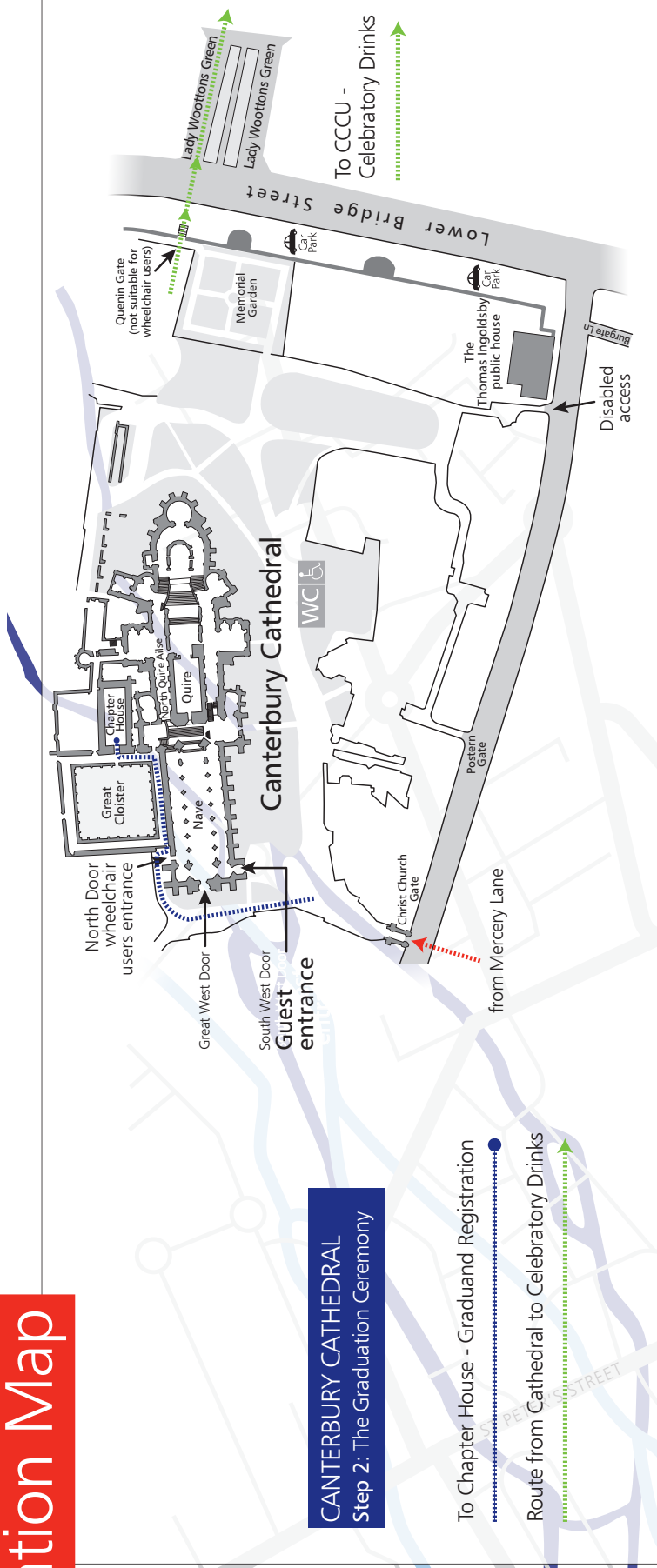
This timetable is for guests, not graduands.

Time	Location	Action
07.15 - 08.45	Augustine House, third floor, AH3.31	Graduand (no guests permitted) collects their pre-ordered graduation gown in AH3.31. Guests then accompany graduand to photographs in Augustine Hall. Graduands should collect their gown early if they plan on having photographs taken prior to the ceremony.
07.15 - 08.45	Augustine House, ground floor foyer	Collect pre-paid guest tickets at the ticket collection desk.
08.45 - 09.15	South West Door, Cathedral	Make your way to the South West Door of the Cathedral for admittance. If you have been advised to use a different entrance please see map overleaf for location. Doors open at 08:45. Please be aware that the queuing area is very open to the elements. While every effort will be made to open the door early in the event of inclement weather, no guarantees can be made. All guests entering the Cathedral must have a ticket, including babies and children – tickets are per person (including babies and children) not per seat and no standing is permitted in the Cathedral. This is to ensure that numbers stay within the health and safety guidelines.
09.30	Nave	Ceremony Marshall reads instructions to graduands and guests.
09.45 - 11.00	Nave Live streaming of the ceremony to St Georges Centre and www.canterbury.ac.uk/graduation-live	Academic, Civic Dignitaries, Honorary and Platform Party processions. The ceremony: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the ceremony will be declared open and welcoming address given • graduands will be presented for their awards • the conferment of an Honorary Graduand of the University (if applicable) • after the presentations there will be a prayer • the ceremony will then be declared closed. The Cathedral ceremony should last approximately 1 hour 15.
11.00 - 11.30	Canterbury Cathedral to North Holmes Road (Anselm Building)	Recessional Procession. Guests must wait until the last procession has left before leaving. If your graduate is not attending the Celebratory Drinks, please return their gown to Augustine House.
11.45 - 13.00	North Holmes Road (Food Court, Chapel and Staff Common Room.)	Celebratory Drinks. Your ticket must be presented upon entry.
11.45 - 13.00	North Holmes Road (Laud) Lg 25 - Gown Return/Award Photos Lg46 & Lg47 - Photography	Accompany the graduate to return their gown. The graduand will be photographed when admitted to their qualification at the Cathedral ceremony. This photograph will be available to view and purchase here on the day or via the Ede & Ravenscroft website www.edeandravenscroft.com after the ceremony.
